## **Golf Course News**

"FROST DELAY", and "Cart Path Only". These are two phrases that golfers dread. Your day is planned and you know you only have a certain amount of time to play golf and then you must be elsewhere. These conditions mess with all our schedules, but if you want to protect your golf course, we have to respect these situations. When you are at the clubhouse and no frost is visible anywhere in sight, Holes 2, 4, 10, and 11 are generally covered with frost due to shade or lower elevations.

Before golfers can go out, I have to anticipate when the starting time can be after the frost has melted and the greens are mowed. If a golfer walks on the turf, the leaf blade can be damaged for weeks if not longer. One person can leave approximately 100 steps on the green. Multiply this with one foursome and so on. We will do our very best to get you out there as soon as possible.

Please repair your ball marks and sand your divots on the fairways and greens! Most importantly, have fun!!!
